Note: Only successful candidates in the written examination and computer practical test shall be called to appear in the Viva-voce test.

Details of Syllabus for each Subject:

- i) **General Knowledge:** - Knowledge of past and current events and such other matters of everyday observation and experience as may be expected from an educated person.
- ii) **Language(Tamil/English):-**
 - a) A letter or application to be written in English – 5 marks
 - b) One Tamil passage to be translated in English – 5 marks
 - c) One English Passage to be translated into Tamil – 5 marks
 - d) Comprehension of one English passage – 5 marks
- iii) **Arithmetic :-** Vulgar fraction and decimals, simple and compound interest, Percentage , Profit and loss, Mixtures, Rates and Taxes, Square and Cubic measures, Problems on time and work and time and distance.
 Note: Problems more easily solvable by algebraic method need not be solved arithmetically
- iv) **Computer Test(Practical) including typing :-** To test the proficiency of the candidate relating to matters like ,Test formatting of the paragraphs , insertion of table , skill to print and save, file transfer, web-site searching/ browsing , downloading e-mail, use of pen drive and other software's, etc and programmes of accounting .
Type test: Type test to be done on computer- candidates shall be required to type out a passage of 400 words in English and 300 words in Tamil

General Instruction:

1. The applicants are instructed to use the prescribed application format for apply the post and shall fill the application in their own hand writing preferably using Black/Blue pens or by computer typed.
2. The applicants should specifically mention the post for which the application is submitted.
3. Separate applications to be submitted for each post.
4. A self addressed postal cover with stamp for Rs.50/- to be enclosed along with all the application without fail.
5. The applicants shall mention their mobile number in the application without fail.
